Cornflake biscuits

200 grams dark chocolate and 100 grams full cream chocolate melted,
Mix with 90 grams of grated coconut and 100 grams of cornflakes.
Put little parts on a baking sheet, put it at a cold place and let it get solid.

Cinnamon Biscuits

Stir 200 gr. butter, 100 gr. sugar, 1 teaspoon cinnamon, 260 gr. flour and 100 gr. ground nuts (almonds?).

Put it a little time at a cold place and then shape it like half moons.

Put it on a baking sheet and bake for about 10 – 12 minutes – until it is light brown.

Mix cinnamon and a little sugar and turn the warm biscuits in that mixture.

From our friends in Bad Salzdetfurth

Bad Salzdetfurth in Germany is near to Hannover and is surrounded with little wooded hills. Friends ask us why we are going on holiday when we have such a wonderful landscape around.

Many people from Yate, who have visited us for a long time, know that all. They can tell you about their trips close to our town and the landscapes nearby.

People from Bad Salzdetfurth have made many friendships with people from Yate and we are always looking forward to coming over to Yate. We also love your countryside with the hedges, old trees and wonderful gardens.

Christmas Traditions in Germany

Now we want tell you something about Christmas time in Germany. It is in some ways a little bit different to yours in Great Britain. When Advent time is coming we decorate our rooms with Christmas facilities, Christmas tree branches in vases – sometimes with electric lights on – everybody has one or more Advent wreaths on their tables or window sills decorated with candles and other things. Every evening we light the candles – one during the first week, two the second week and so on.....

And many women are baking special biscuits.

For Christmas Eve we have a Christmas tree, decorated with coloured bowls, angels, Christmas figures and candles, of course. For the little children their parents put the presents around the Christmas tree and it is forbidden to the children to enter that room before their parents allow it. So is the surprise big for them.

Most families are going to a church service and after the service they have the distribution of gifts. Then all the families have their special Christmas meal. That is quite different – some have turkey, some have trout or some have just a potato salad with special sausages.

The next two Christmas days relations and friends are coming for a visit or you visit friends or relations.

It is forbidden for children to enter the room before parents allow it.....
